



### **A Day at your Dream Job**

*Summary:* Let your child explore what they might need and who they might meet at their dream job.

*Age Group:* Grades Kindergarten through 2<sup>nd</sup>

*Materials:* Coloring supplies, a printer or piece of notebook paper

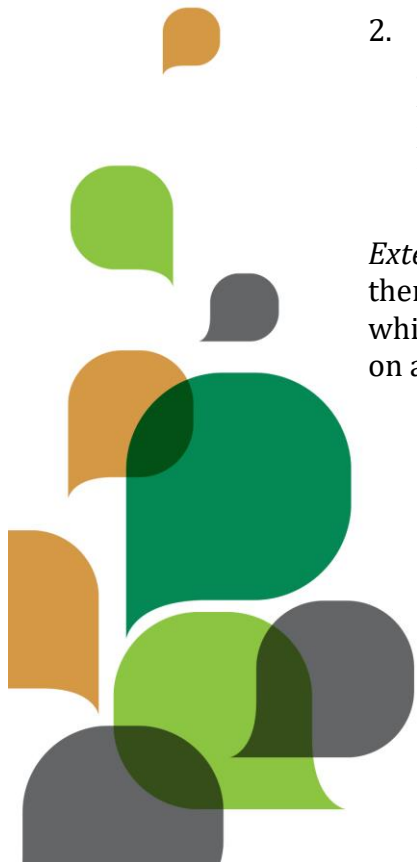
*Instructions:*

Ask your child what type of job they might want to have when they grow up.

1. Talk to them about where people with these jobs work, what types of tools they need for their job, and who they might meet when they are working.
2. Print out the last page of this handout for your child. If you don't have access to a printer, have your child divide a piece of paper into 4 equal parts. Have them draw their pictures to each question in the spaces provided OR have them draw one big picture that answers all four questions.

*Extension:* Talk to your child about what you do in your job. Describe for them where you work, the tools that you use, and the people you meet while working. Have your child draw pictures to each of these questions on a blank piece of paper or on a second copy of the printout.
