

A Region's Market

Summary: Use your knowledge of charts and math to compare how much produce different farmers grow.

Age Group: Grades 3rd through 5th

Materials: Scrap paper and pencil

Instructions:

The chart below shows how many pounds of produce each of the farmers sold from April to September. Look at the chart below, then answer the questions that follow.

	April	May	June	July	August	September
Farmer Jake	120	125	250	100	250	300
Farmer Samar	495	320	250	170	160	210
Farmer Chris	500	670	320	450	555	330
Farmer Ravi	500	745	290	450	320	800

1. Who sold the least amount of produce in April?
2. How much produce was sold in total in August?
3. Who sold the most produce from April to September, Chris or Ravi?
4. What was Samar's average sale per month over the six months?

Extension: Choose one of the farmers. Create a business for them to sell their produce. Come up with a business name, a slogan, and fliers or an advertisement to tell people about your business and why they should buy your produce.

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
